

Preparing Supporting Documents For 212(c) Hearing.

Documents to prepare

Tax Returns

- Income tax returns for at least the last ten years.

Proof of Property Ownership

- Deed of Trust on your home (proof of property ownership)
- General Warranty deed on your home

Ties to the Business Community

- Resume'
- Letters of Character from current employer, and past employers.

Letters of Character from Associates and Organizations

- From CIEJ
- Possibly Professor Morawetz

Letters of Character from Family Members

- Spouse
- Children
- Any family member in the U.S.

Letters of Character from Friends

- Letters from as many friends and acquaintance as you can get.
- Letters from church friends
- Letter from you pastor/priest

Photos

- Include photos copied onto legal paper. (You can usually do this at Kinko's on their color copier)
- Photos should portray as much ties to family and friends in the U.S. as possible.

I recommend that you make a cover sheet that could say something like

Name

Supporting
Documents
For
Relief
From
Deportation

212(c)

And also make a cover sheet for each section. You can title them with the cover page format using the categories I have listed above, or just be creative.

Make 4 copies. Keep one for yourself, and send the other three to your attorney. He will need a copy and one for the judge and trial attorney.
